

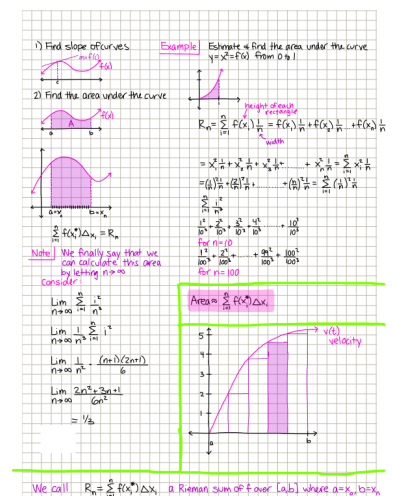
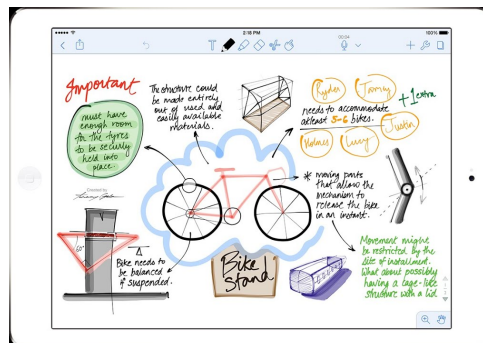
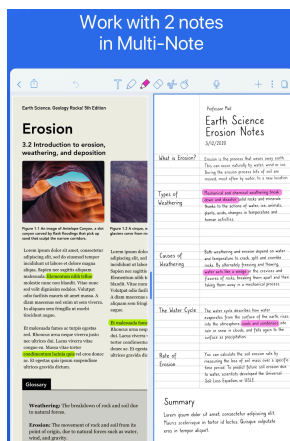
# Teaching with Notability

## What is Notability

Notability is a note-taking app that allows you to annotate documents, write, draw, speak, organize, and share your notes.

| What Can Teachers Do?                               | What Can Students Do?  |

| Illustrate Concepts                                 | Create Outlines  |

| Record Lectures/Provide Audio Feedback              | Add photos, gifs, web pages, and more                                    |


# Import Saved PDF Files
