

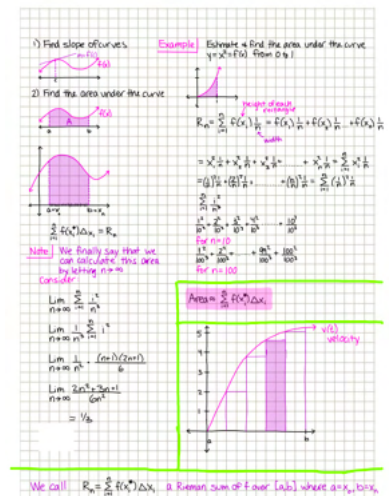
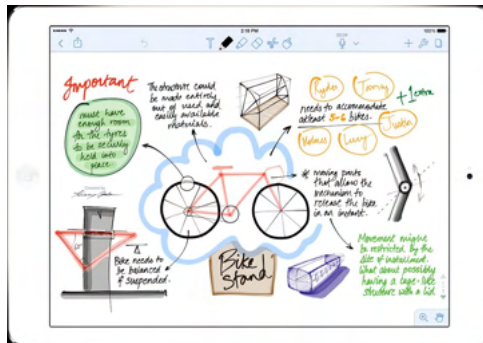
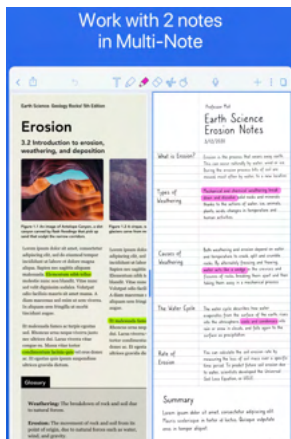
# Teaching with Notability

## What is Notability

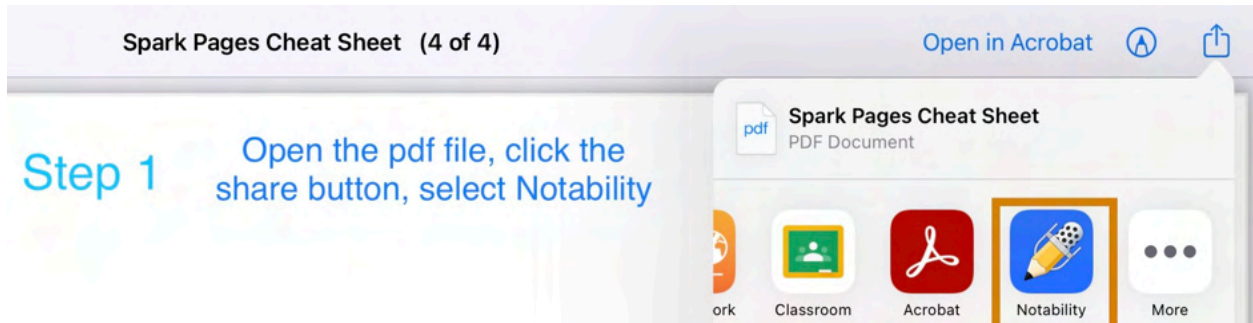
Notability is a note-taking app that allows you to annotate documents, write, draw, speak, organize, and share your notes.

What Can Teachers Do?	What Can Students Do?
Import, Annotate, and Share Files and Presentations	Group Notes with Subjects and Dividers
Illustrate Concepts	Create Outlines
Create Visual Study Guides	Work with two notes side-by-side
Share Ideas in Presentation Mode	Create Audio Notes
Record Lectures/Provide Audio Feedback	Add photos, gifs, web pages, and more
Create Interactive Checklists	Mark up imported textbooks, documents, lecture slides, class assignments
Import Books and Images	Explore endless ideas with continuous page scroll

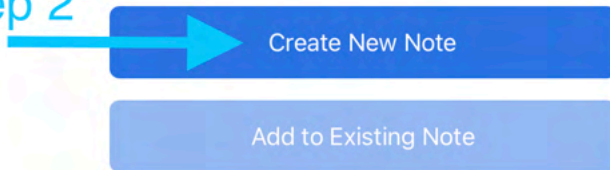

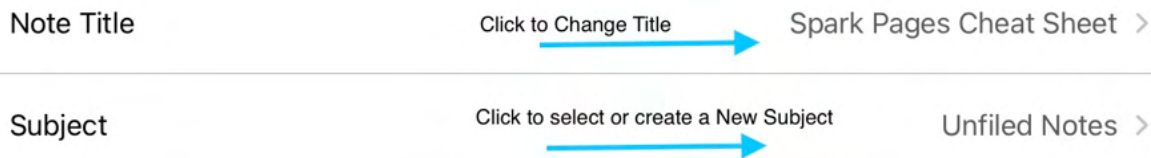

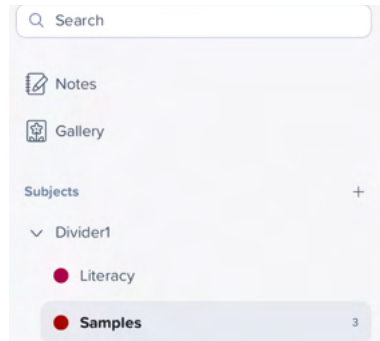

# Create a Note



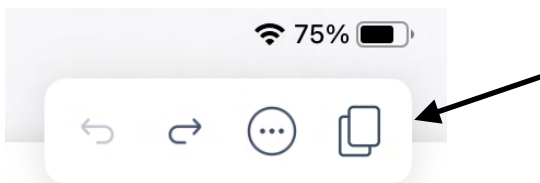
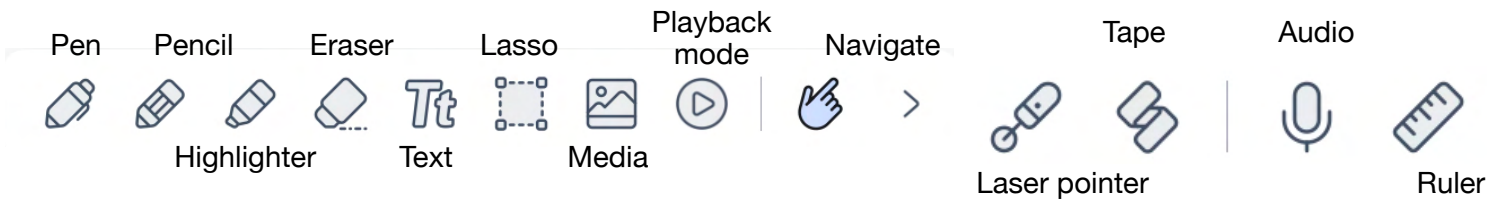
Click here to Create a new note.



Select where you would like to create your note

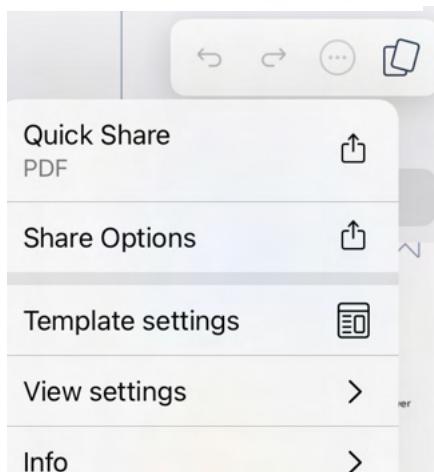


Use one of the following options, located on the **bottom of a new note**, to change the background: **Rule, Grid, and Dot.**



Tap here in the upper right corner of a note to open the **Page Manager**.

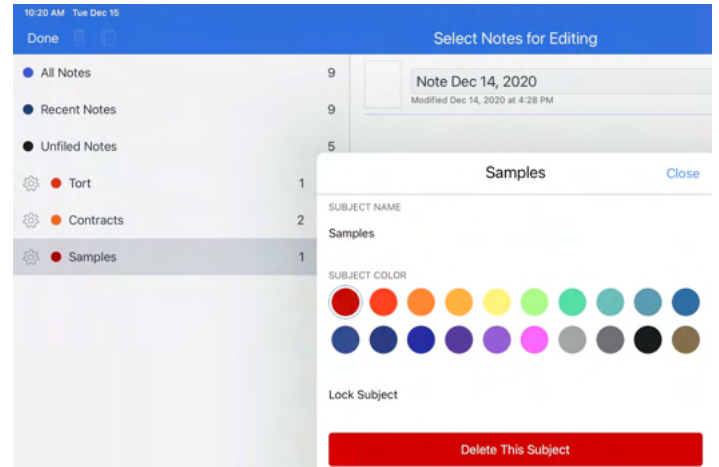
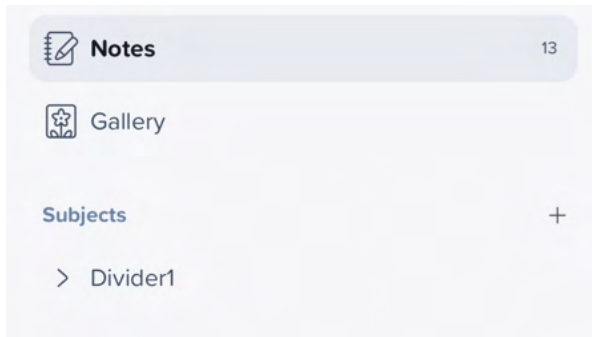
**All Pages** displays the thumbnails for all of the pages.

Click the + to Add a new Subject or Divider
